UNIT 1: The hospital team. (20 septiembre- 2 octubre / 24 enero- 5 febrero) 4 sesiones

UNIT 2: In and around the hospital. (4 octubre – 9 octubre/ 7 febrero- 19 febrero) 2 sesiones

- Describing what different hospital departments do.

- Describing where things are.
- Giving directions in a hospital and via email.

UNIT 3: Hospital admissions. (11 octubre – 16 octubre/ 21 febrero- 26 febrero) 2 sesiones

- Describing how to deal with in an emergency.
- Explaining procedures. Making polite requests to patients and colleagues.
